



**NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper**  
*Capsicum annuum 'NuMex Easter'*

**Description:**

This variety produces a dense compact plant with pointy green foliage; small clusters of fruit range from lavender-purple, creamy yellow, and orange when they mature; fruit resembles the pastel colors of Easter eggs; stunning in a container display

**Ornamental Features**

NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper is primarily grown for its highly ornamental fruit. The fruits are showy lavender peppers with yellow overtones and which fade to orange over time, which are carried in abundance from mid summer to early fall. Its attractive pointy leaves remain green in colour throughout the season. It features subtle white star-shaped flowers dangling from the stems from late spring to mid summer.

This plant is primarily grown as an ornamental, but it's also valued for its edible qualities. The oblong spicy peppers are most often used in the following ways:

- Cooking
- Drying
- Pickling
- Seasoning
- Sauces

**Landscape Attributes**

NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper is an herbaceous annual with an upright spreading habit of growth. Its medium texture blends into the garden, but can always be balanced by a couple of finer or coarser plants for an effective composition.

This plant will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should not require much pruning, except when necessary, such as to remove dieback. Deer don't particularly care for this plant and will usually leave it alone in favor of tastier treats. It has no significant negative characteristics.

NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- Mass Planting
- Border Edging
- General Garden Use
- Herb Gardens
- Container Planting
- Hanging Baskets

#### **Planting & Growing**

NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper will grow to be about 12 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 12 inches. This vegetable plant is an annual, which means that it will grow for one season in your garden and then die after producing a crop.

This plant should only be grown in full sunlight. It is very adaptable to both dry and moist growing conditions, but will not tolerate any standing water. It is not particular as to soil type or pH. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This is a selected variety of a species not originally from North America. It can be propagated by cuttings; however, as a cultivated variety, be aware that it may be subject to certain restrictions or prohibitions on propagation.

NuMex Easter Ornamental Pepper is a fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor containers and hanging baskets. It is often used as a 'filler' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, providing a mass of flowers and foliage against which the larger thriller plants stand out. Note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden.
